According to the [Center for Disease Control](#) and [U.S. Census Bureau](#), both marriage and divorce rates in the United States declined from 2009 to 2019 but rates vary from state to state. Data suggests there were 16.3 new marriages for every 1,000 women age 15 and over in the U.S., down from 17.6 in 2009.

At the same time, the U.S. divorce rate fell from 9.7 new divorces per 1,000 women age 15 and over in 2009 to 7.6 in 2019. While divorce rates are down, COVID-19 presents new complications with clients dealing with child custody and co-parenting; legal battles over child tax credits as it relates to the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, custody and visitation rights during COVID-19 mandated lockdowns and stay-at-home orders.

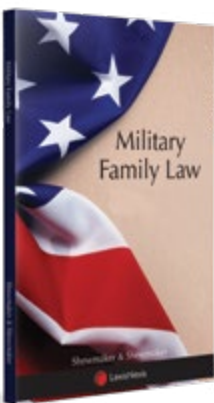

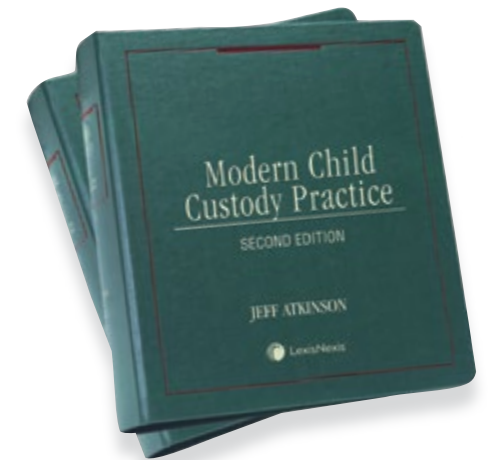

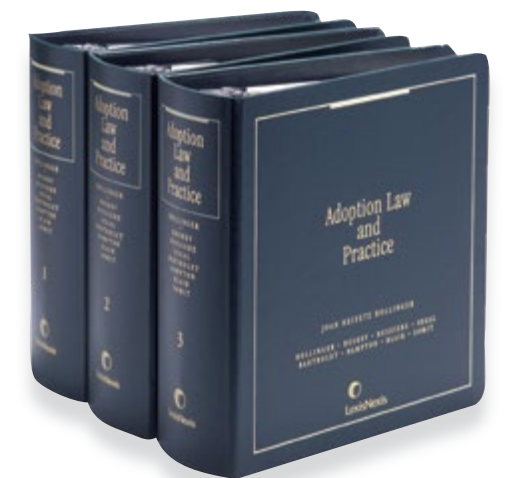
