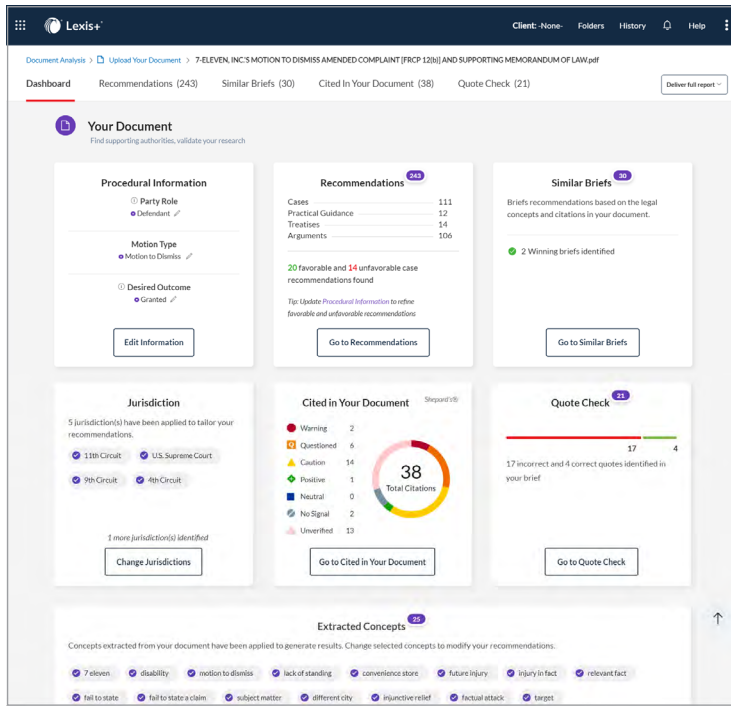

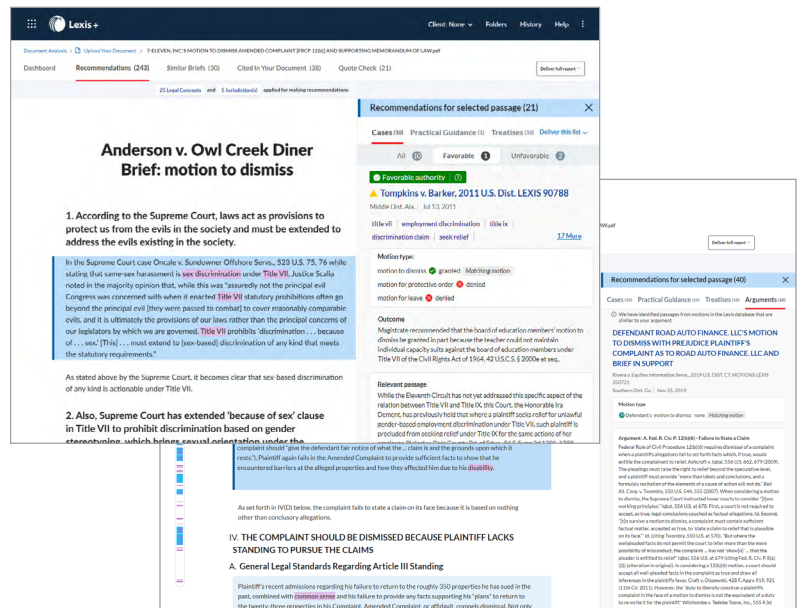

- View the automatically detected and applied Jurisdictions, with the ability to edit.

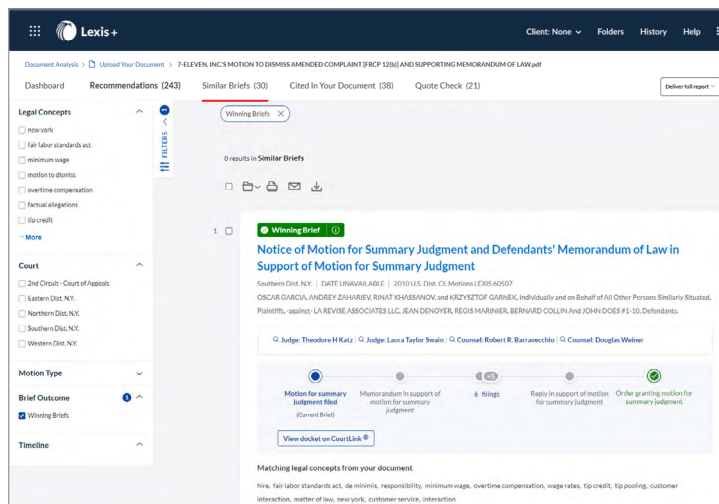
Strengthen Arguments and Uncover Weaknesses:

- Gain further insight from leading secondary sources and **Practical Guidance** to craft a winning strategy.



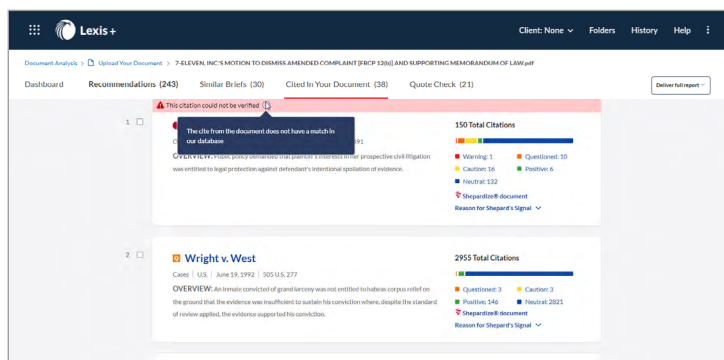

- Filter by specific legal concepts, court, timeline, motion type, and winning briefs.



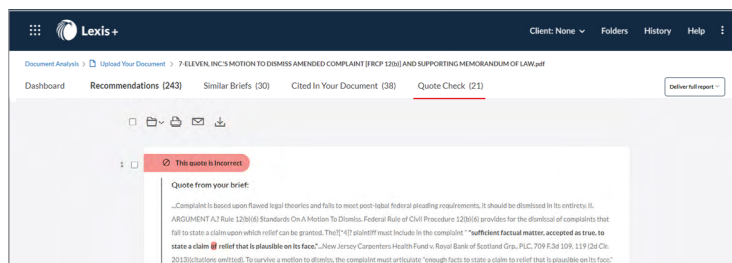
Validate Cites are Good Law

- Finalize with this essential feature that detects errors in cited quotes, further ensuring a high-quality brief every time.



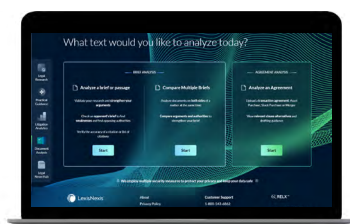
