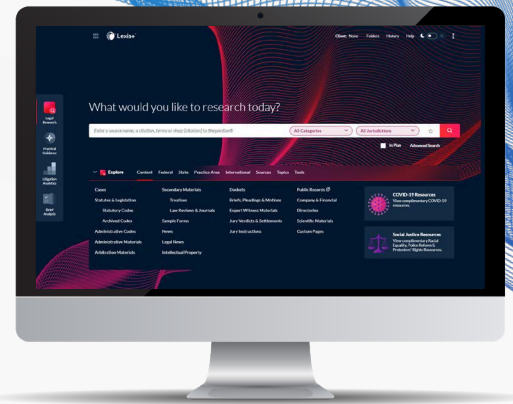


# Be Sure Your Cases Are Good Law

## Top three tips:

### ACCESSING A SHEPARD'S REPORT

There are three ways to access a *Shepard's* report: 1) click the *Shepard's* Signal<sup>™</sup> indicator next to the case name; 2) enter *shep:* and the cite in the Search Box (e.g., *shep: 591 f3d 1232*); and 3) click *Shepardize*<sup>®</sup> document in the *Shepard's* preview of any case.

### UTILIZE FILTERS TO NARROW YOUR SHEPARD'S REPORT

Filter citing references to identify vital cases. Filter by treatment, jurisdiction, depth of discussion, headnote or time frame. Refine further by specific words within your *Shepard's* report.
