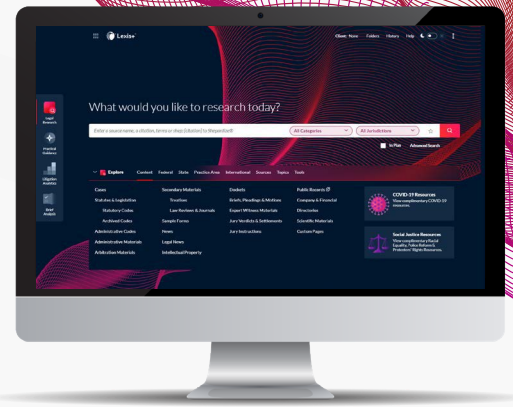


The Best Way To Prepare For Class

Three Class Preparation Steps:

1

REVIEW THE LAW SCHOOL CASE BRIEF

READ THE CASE IN YOUR TEXTBOOK/CASEBOOK

After reviewing the LexisNexis® case brief, read the case. The knowledge you've gained from the brief will direct your reading and ensure you know what to look for as you read.

USE LEXISNEXIS® HEADNOTES TO CREATE YOUR OWN BRIEF

You've reviewed the LexisNexis® case brief and read the case. Now create your own brief using LexisNexis® Headnotes. These are direct quotes from the important points of law in your case. They act as a safety net ensuring you don't miss anything.
